# COMMUNITY & FUNDRAISING

Summer Social: our Summer Social took place on 9th Sept, in partnership with The Yateley Society. It was a huge success raising £1688 which was split equally between the two charities.

Twilight Runway Challenge: a team made up of 11 staff, residents and supporters took part in this Challenge at Blackbushe Airport on 16th Sept. Participants wheeled, walked, ran or cycled between 5 & 10k and raised over £2200 in sponsorship.

Volunteer Days: we were pleased to have two teams come in recently to tidy up our outdoor space. Community Matters
Partnership Project with Alphabet GB, and then Hart District Council Countryside Rangers. Each spent a day cutting back trees and clearing undergrowth around the site to improve the outdoor space for our staff and residents.

# COMMUNITY PANTRY

The Community Pantry is open 10am - 2pm on Tues, Wed and Fri each week and now supports 670 families. We had a total of 412 visits in October, with twice as many new sign ups in October than during the summer.





Last year our Pantry Garden was chosen as the Co-op Local Community Funding Partner.

An amazing £2,890.84 has been raised which will go towards making the green space wheelchair accessible. Thank you to Co-op members that chose our Pantry Garden as their local cause!
